Wansford Pasture Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) - Changes to Public Rights of Way and Permissive access provisions.

Wansford Pasture SSSI is owned and managed by The Wildlife Trusts for Beds, Cambs & N'hants, a local conservation charity, as a Nature Reserve. Public access to the site is either on the Public Footpath or via other footpaths with the landowner's permission (Permissive Access) and this latter can be withdrawn at any point, at the owner's discretion, for any period of time.

The Public Right of Way (PROW) crosses the field from the King's Cliffe/ Old Leicester Road Junction heading roughly South to the footbridge, where it crosses into Northamptonshire.

THE PERMISSIVE FOOTPATH IS NOW CLOSED.

Please use the official PROW entrance points & route. Given the SSSI designation there is no intention to provide a hard or level surface on the PROW route.
